

A SELECT BOARD RESOLUTION
HONORING ANNA (CANNEY) RADOCK and EDWARD RADOCK
ON THE DEDICATION OF
RADOCK FAMILY SQUARE
IN THE TOWN OF NATICK, MA

Whereas, on March 26, 2022, the corner of Atherton and High Streets will be dedicated as the Radock Square in honor of Anna (Canney) Radock and Edward Radock, who both served in the armed forces; and

Whereas, Anna (Canney) Radock served in the U.S. Navy at the Pentagon, reaching the rank of Yeoman Second Class; and

Whereas, Edward Radock served in the U.S. Navy on the U.S.S. Baltimore, reaching the rank of Radarman Second Class; and

Whereas, Edward Radock was awarded the WWII Victor Medal, the Asian-Pacific Theatre Medal with nine stars, the Philippine Liberation Medal, the American Theatre Medal and the Good Conduct Medal; and

Whereas, Anna and Edward were married, moved to Natick, and raised their family at 3 Atherton Street for over 65 years; and

Whereas, Anna and Edward were committed to the Natick community, with Anna having served the Town as a bookkeeper, while in his retirement, Edward served in the Records office at the Police Department, in addition to his profession as a Registered Pharmacist; and

Whereas, Edward, following Anna's death in 2000, has been devoted to the Veterans' Oral History Project, the annual Veterans' Breakfast at the Kennedy Middle School, and speaking at the former World War II Museum which was based in Natick.

Now, Therefore, be it Resolved that the Natick, Massachusetts Select Board hereby honors the Radock family on the occasion of the Dedication of the Radock Family Square; and that a copy of this Resolution shall be transmitted forthwith by the Natick Select Board to the Radock Family.
